Thought for the day:

A little girl, Andrea, once asked Pope Benedict about His First Holy Communion. His answer gives us thought for reflection and prayer.

Andrea: Dear Pope, what are your memories of your First Communion day?

Pope Benedict: Andrea, I would first like to say thank you for your question.

Of course I remember my First Communion day very well. A lovely Sunday in March 1936, 69 years ago. It was a sunny and the church looked very beautiful, there was music.

There were about 30 of us, boys and girls from my little village. When I received Communion I understood that Jesus had entered my heart, he had actually visited me. With Jesus, God himself was with me. I realized that this is a gift of love - truly worth more than all the other things that life can give.

That day, I promised the Lord: "I always want to stay with you", and I prayed to him, "but above all, stay with me". So I went on living my life like that; thanks be to God, the Lord has always taken me by the hand and guided me, even in difficult situations.

The day of my First Communion was the beginning of a journey made together. I hope that for all of you too, the First Communion you will receive this Year will be the beginning of a lifelong friendship with Jesus, the beginning of a journey together, because in walking with Jesus we do well and life becomes good.

Prayer: Jesus, I love you with all my heart. Help me to prepare to receive you in Holy Communion and say with me always, every moment of each day and help me to stay with you always. Amen
