Thought for the day: Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi

The Feast of Corpus Christi is the name of this feast celebrating the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is also called Communion, the Lord's Supper, or the Mass (from the Latin word meaning "to dismiss"). Holy Thursday was the day Jesus actually instituted the sacrament. The Sunday after Trinity Sunday is now the day chosen for the Corpus Christi feast.

Typically, Corpus Christi services consist of singing traditional hymns, Lauda Sion and Pange Lingua, both attributed to St. Thomas Aquinas. Outdoor processions of the Blessed Sacrament are common in some churches as a way to celebrate Corpus Christi. Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction are also common Corpus Christi devotional practices in many churches. The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch" (St. Thomas Aquinas, 1324). We remember and we pray for all the children from the parish school who made their First Holy Communion last weekend.

Prayer: O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament divine, All praise and all thanksgiving, be every moment thine.
