### Good Hygiene Practices

Given the increase in the numbers of people affected by influenza in recent weeks, it  
 is opportune to remind ourselves of sensible practices. It's good to remember that  
 those with flu symptoms are dispensed from their Sunday obligation to attend Mass.  
 Those who are confined to home when ill can honour the Lord's Day by praying  
 along with the Mass broadcast by Parish Radio, on webcams, on Sunday Morning by  
 RTE Radio on Long Wave 252 Khz. RTE1 television often broadcast Mass on Sunday  
 mornings too.

In times of previous flu alerts the Health Service Executive stated:  
 "Shaking hands while exchanging the 'Sign of Peace' involves a low  
 risk of spreading the virus."



If some parishioners still feel uncomfortable about shaking hands at the Sign of  
 Peace, they are very welcome to wish others the Peace of Christ without hand  
 contact (**with a smile or a bow**)
