

**Bishop Fintan Gavin ordained as Bishop of Cork & Ross**



Fr Fintan Gavin, from Marino in Dublin, was ordained bishop of the Diocese of Cork and Ross in a ceremony at Cork city's North Cathedral on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> June . The 53-year-old Dubliner has become the first non-Cork born priest to be ordained bishop of the diocese in more than 300 years. The diocese is the third largest Catholic diocese in the country with a Catholic population of around 285,000, across 68 parishes, it stretches from Sherkin Island in the west of the county, to the urban parishes of Cork City, with some 80 priests in active ministry. It was the first ordination of a Catholic bishop in Cork since

1984 when Bishop John Buckley was ordained Auxiliary Bishop. Around 1,200 attended the ceremony, among them 110 priests including the Archbishop of Dublin Dr Diarmuid Martin and the Papal Nuncio to Ireland Archbishop Jude Thaddeus Okolo.

In a spirit of ecumenicalism, the bells of the Church of Ireland Cathedral in Cork city rang out to welcome the ordination of the city's new Catholic bishop.

Appointed in April by Pope Francis to succeed Bishop John Buckley, the Dubliner was chancellor in the Archdiocese of Dublin and parish chaplain at Our Lady of Victories, Ballymun Road. Speaking at the beginning of the ceremony, Emeritus Bishop of Cork and Ross Dr John Buckley said it was an honour for him to ordain his successor. Bishop Gavin also told the gathering that the Church has to find new ways of dealing with the challenges confronting it today. It needs to encourage more vocations to the priesthood and to reach out to those who have lost their faith or are struggling. We wish him every success in his new mission.
